



## Installation instructions:


By following the instructions below, everything should be fine!



Rear view

### 1 -

Two blades are not assembled. They are marked by a black dot at the tip.




### 2 -

Remove the two blades and screw the bulb of your choice (energy saving bulb).

### NOTE:

Once the bulb screwed, adjust the blades into the slots to form a circle at the end of lamp.

To replace the bulb, simply remove the two marked blades.



### 4 -

Turn off the power and then pass the cord through the different items in the order above. Adjust wire to the desired length by cutting or by using the cable-blocker. Pull the drawstring to clamp down on the ceiling.

## Installation, maintenance and usage tips:

Congratulations, you have the Fève!

So take care when unpacking and place the pieces on a flat surface to prevent damage.

The Fève is made of wood and therefore it's alive! Before assembly, it is advisable to wait a few days so that your lamp adapts to its new environment (avoid wet areas).

If you still run into a recalcitrant nesting, sand lightly inside the notch with sandpaper.

This light fixture is designed for indoor use and in dry locations only.

Do not connect until it is fully and properly assembled.

For your Fève to remain beautiful, be sure to remove any dust with a damp cloth without using detergent.

Do not plug the cord or plug if it is damaged. If Fève is not working properly, if it fell, was damaged or remained outside, do not attempt to use it.

For it to remain in shape, unplug the Fève before changing the bulb.

In conclusion, be reasonable, use your Fève in normal use!
